Mr. SAKAGUCHI registered with the Custodian on July 24/42 and was evacuated on March 10/42. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area of B.C.

On March 20/42 he surrendered a Trans-Continental radio, mantel type, to the R.C.M.P. which they handed over to the Custodian on Dec. 17/43. It was sold at auction for the net sum of \$13.06 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against SAKAGUCHI or his wife Shisuye, File No. 12629.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
