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

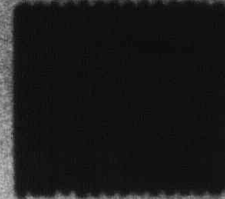

Further to our letter dated April 6th we are happy to be able to report to you now that Mr. Takisaburo Ozaki, Police Registration No. 08639, is reported by the B. C. Security Commission to be living in New Denver, B. C. This information was originally requested by you in your letter dated March 31st.

Perhaps it would not be inappropriate to call your attention to the fact that the actual movement, location and control of individuals of the Japanese race who have been evacuated from the Protected Area is entirely in the hands of the B. C. Security Commission, and to obtain addresses for you it is necessary for us in each instance to get in touch with the B. C. Security Commission as they have the information and we do not have it. We therefore suggest that in the interests of economy of time and effort, you may possibly wish to consider the practicability of securing information of this nature hereafter by making application direct to the B. C. Security Commission, Marine Building, Vancouver, B. C.

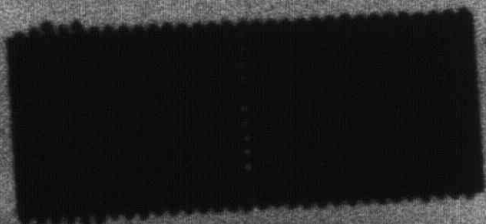

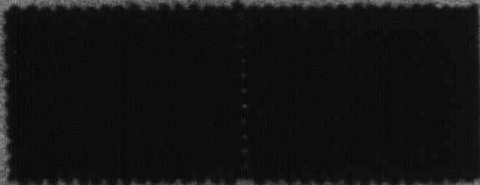
