PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Heikichi SAKAMOTO, Reg. No. 00460

This file reveals that SAKAMOTO owned no real property in any protected area of B. C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: SAKAMOTO made his declaration to the Custodian on July 24/42 and was evacuated on Aug. 11/42. He declared no chattels and none were found by the Custodian belonging to him.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: On March 9/42 SAKAMOTO surrendered to the R.C.M.P. a Westinghouse radio. SAKAMOTO advised that he could sell his radio to a Mr. John Maclean of Greenwood and asked that the radio be shipped to Mr. Maclean. This radio was released to the B.C.S.C. for shipment to Mr. Maclean on Jan. 5/44. The sum of \$1.00 storage was charged on this radio and this amount deducted from his credit with the Custodian.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The account of SAKAMOTO was credited with the sum of \$4.44 being a refund of 1½ wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: He declared two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in the possession of his wife at Greenwood. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: He declared a joint life insurance policy for himself and his wife with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. in the sum of \$2000.00, in the possession of his wife at Greenwood. This policy was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
