
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

The Government of Canada acknowledges that the United States has loaned to the Government of Canada the sum of one million dollars and agrees to remit the yen equivalent of the net proceeds of such payments immediately, or upon liquidation if such action is required, to Japan under arrangements made with, and approved by, the United States Government and the Military Authorities in Japan; Provided that from the proceeds of such payments there shall be retained such amounts as are required to repay advances made by the Government of Canada by way of Registration Grants.
