The deceased did not make a declaration to the Custodian and nothing is known of her assets.

The only claim appearing on this file is for the sum of \$50.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission for her burial. They advised, in a letter dated March 23, 1943, that they did not wish us to endeavour to collect this claim from the sons of the deceased.

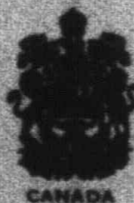
