

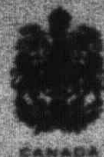

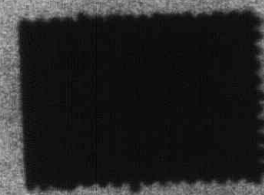

Dear Sir:

Your file in this office shows that, on May 5, 1942, in your declaration to the Custodian, you reported ownership of one Victory Bond valued at \$50.00 in your own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Although the Victory Bond was the only property declared by you, the Britannia Mining and Smelting Co. Limited reported to this office, on May 7, 1942, that one kori, one trunk and one box of clothing belonging to you were stored at Britannia Beach. On November 24, 1942, you stated that these were all the chattels belonging to you left in the protected area.

The kori, the trunk and a bag of clothing were shipped to the British Columbia Security Commission, in the summer of 1943, for delivery to you.

Some tools and coat hangers, identified as your property, were sold at auction by the Custodian for the net sum of \$1.85, which was credited to your account with this office.

The sum of \$26.79 was credited to your account with this office. This sum was received from the Commissioner of Income Tax, Ottawa, and was a refund of income tax for the year 1942.

Your credit balance in the Custodian Trust Account, at this date, is \$28.64.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area and, in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
