On authority of U. Sakamoto, attorney for Mitsuzo KOKUBA (Internee File 810) the sum of \$368.75, proceeds from the sale of the vessel "T.K"/"M.K." NW.1184, was paid to Miss Haruye KOKUBO, on August 25, 1942.

The boat, licensed NW.1184, was in the name of Tokogu (or Takezo, or Takeo) KOKUBO, said to be the deceased father of Haruye and Mitsuzo KOKUBO.

This boat was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee and payment was made direct to Miss KOKUBO.

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P. S. Haruye KOKUBO's file states that her father Takeju KOKUBO is in Japan.

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
