GENERAL SUMMARY

Kazuma TSUKIKAWA died at New Denver, B. C. on November 19, 1944, at the age of 70 years. He was single and both parents were dead.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none appear on file.

A claim in the amount of \$3.25 was filed against Tsukikawa by P. S. Ross & Sons on behalf of O. Kondo Co. They were advised that the debtor had died and that there were no funds available from which to pay their claim. The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of the deceased for the sum of \$3.00 to cover the balance of his funeral expenses. The original bill for funeral had been reduced from \$80.00 by applying the sum of \$76.80 which was owing to Tsukikawa for wages. The Commission was advised that there were no funds belonging to the deceased in the hands of the Custodian.
