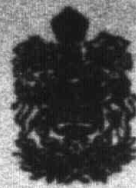

GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 11891

October 6, 1947

Re: Asae KUMANO, Reg. No. 01260

Prior to her evacuation Mrs. KUMANO lived in rented premises at 203 Powell. She signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 27, 1942. She was evacuated on September 9, 1942.

In her declaration, Mrs. KUMANO reported that she had left with Mr. Nakahama, 250 Powell Street, the following goods:

- 5 Bundles of Dolls
- 1 Bureau with Dishes in the Drawers
- 1 Chest of Drawers

On May 22, 1944, there were shipped to the husband of Asae KUMANO, the bureau, the dresser, a mirror, 3 cartons and a box. This shipment covered all the items declared with the exception of 3 bundles of dolls. The goods shipped had been identified by the husband of Mrs. KUMANO, who visited Vancouver.

As festival dolls, which were not declared by the NAKAHAMA family, were removed from 250 Powell, and sold at auction, the proceeds from the sale of some of these dolls have been credited to the account of Mrs. KUMANO.

Mrs. KUMANO declared two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

Matsujiro WATADA, Reg.No. 10885, File 9419, and Asae KUMANO, Reg.No. 01260, File 11891, did declare "toys, materials & clothes bag" and "3 bundles of dolls", left at 250 Powell Street, which have not been accounted for. The goods sold at Vancouver 56, December 7, 1945, were removed from 250 Powell. It would appear that these are the missing goods of Matsujiro WATADA and Asae KUMANO.
