Dr. H. UCHIDA withdrew his claim.

Mr. Tokuso WAKABAYASHI was notified of the other two claims and requested to authorize us to pay these on March 16, 1944 and May 17, 1944. Having received no reply, on June 29, 1944, the creditors were advised that we had been unsuccessful in collecting their accounts.

On February 26, 1945, Tokuso WAKABAYASHI asked for information regarding his radio. We advised him that the proceeds of sale of same were being held until we received the R. C. N. P. Radio receipt and that his claims were as yet unsettled. We wrote to him again on September 13, 1945 and stipulated that if we did not receive a reply before September 30, 1945 we would pay the claims and hold the balance.

This was an error as we cannot distribute the proceeds of sale of a radio unless we have the R. C. N. P. receipt which is proof of ownership. Consequently the claims have not been paid and the balance now on file is \$61.42, \$56.06 proceeds of radio and \$5.34 refund of 15% Wage deduction.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: WAKABAYASHI, Tokuzo - Reg. No. 06342.

While evidence on this file shows that the above was evacuated on March 10, 1942, his registration form was completed at Hastings Park on July 27, 1942. It is possible that he returned to Vancouver to visit his family who were not evacuated until September 9, 1942.

SPECIFIED

ARTICLES: A radio was received in the name of the above from the R.C.M.P., on December 17, 1943 and sold in Auction Sale Vancouver Radio 1, December 20, 1943 for the net sum of \$56.08. On February 26, 1945, Tokuzo WAKABAYASHI requested information regarding his radio and was advised on March 10, 1945 and again on September 13, 1945 that we required the radio receipt before any funds could be released. He failed to reply.

BONDS

WAR SAVINGS

CERTIFICATES: He declared 9 \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, 4 of which were being sent to Ottawa to be cashed and the other 5 were in his possession. None of these were brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE

INSURANCE: He declared a \$500.00 Insurance Policy with the Mutual Life Insurance Co., in his own possession. This policy was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

A refund of 1% Wage Deduction for the period from January to June 1941 was received from the Provincial Collector. This amounted to \$5.34.

This file reveals no other property.
