GENERAL SUMMARY.

Est. Takeki SAIKI, Reg. No. 09588.

ASSETS.

No Assets of Takeki SAIKI are declared by him. In his letter of the 2nd April, 1943 he states "In this connection I have nothing remaining Property in Protected Area." However, the file later reveals that he had delivered to the R.C.M.P. on March 10, 1942 a General Electric Radio Serial No. 304 - Model K 8L. This was sold at Auction Sale 17 - April 18, 1944 for net amount of \$25.36 and is now standing to the credit of Takeki SAIKI on our books.

No other assets are revealed on the file.

LIABILITIES.

A claim for B.C. Telephone Co. for \$5.92 against Takeki SAIKI, trading as McMillan Bros. 951 1/2 Nicola Street, Vancouver, B.C. is revealed on the file. Various submissions of this claim to him have brought denials and we are today reporting to the B.C. Telephone Co. that we are unable to effect collection and shall leave the matter in their hands.

No other claims or indebtedness are revealed on the file.
