CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on June 14, 1943, and was evacuated on August 4, 1942, declared the following chattels:

1 Stove
1 Bed
Chinaware
Kitchen utensils

These were stated to have been left in No. 7 cabin at 343 West 5th Av. Our investigators were informed that these articles had been sold or removed by HARADA prior to his evacuation and he was advised accordingly by us on July 30th, 1943. Having no reply from him it can be assumed that our information was correct.

The file reveals no specified articles owned by the above.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: The above declared that four \$5.00 War Savings Certificates had been taken from him by the Guard at Gasnelle, B.C., which were to be sent to Vancouver. No further evidence on file indicates the final disposition of these certificates. They did not come under the control of the Custodian.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The above declared that a Mr. Kanehiko TANAKA owed him the sum of \$1500.00. We failed to contact such person and so advised Mr. HARADA and suggested that he take his own measures to effect collection of this debt.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

We have endeavoured to locate such a person, without success, and, therefore, assume that the foregoing is correct.

In view of this we are taking no action, and it will be necessary that you endeavour to collect this account yourself, taking such measures as you deem desirable.

Dear Sir:

Your file has been reviewed and the following has been noted.

At the time you registered with the Custodian you declared a few chattels at 343 West 5th Ave. Our investigators called to remove these articles to Custodian warehouse only to be informed that such articles were not there, and as we advised you in our letter of July 30th, 1943, we were informed that you had disposed of same prior to your evacuation. We received no reply from you and so assume that this information was correct.

You stated in your declaration that four \$5.00 War Savings Certificates had been taken from you by the Guard at Gasnelle, B.C., which were to be sent to Vancouver. We presume you recovered these certificates as we heard nothing further from you on the subject, and so these certificates did not come under our control.

You declared that a Mr. Azenhiko TAPANA owed you the sum of \$1500.00. We failed to locate and identify such person and wrote advising you of this and suggested that you take your own measures to effect collection of this debt.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.




