This file reveals that Mrs. MOTOMURA owned no real property in any protected area of B. C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. MOTOMURA made her declaration to the Custodian on July 28/42 and declared chattels as shown on Schedule on file left at 526 Princess St. We inventoried 6 boxes in her name at this address and on Sept. 18/42 she confirmed that these 6 boxes were all the chattels she had left in the protected area. Contents of these boxes were sold at auction for the net sum of \$6.46 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.

The Japanese dolls and harp declared by Mrs. MOTOMURA were either not in the boxes we inventoried or may have been put up for auction and no bid received.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: She declared four \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.


