
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that FUJUI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: FUKUI made his declaration to the Custodian on Sept. 25/42 and was evacuated on March 19/42. He declared no property of any kind whatsoever.

However Rev. TASHIRO, minister of the Tenrikyo Canada Church, 526 E. Cordova St., declared on Aug. 27/42 that Shichizo FUKUI had stored one box of clothes and misc. and one bed in the church. We inventoried one box and one bed at this address. The contents of the box were sold at auction for the net sum of \$7.11 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

The spring of bed, inventoried by the Custodian, was apparently of no value and was likely discarded.

LIFE INSURANCE: We received a letter from FUKUI dated Sept. 8/42 asking us to pay the premium due on his policy with the Monarch Life Assurance Co. However as we had no funds to his credit at that time we advised him that we would be unable to carry out his request and he would have to take care of this premium himself.

FUKUI was repatriated on May 31/46.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


