This man did not sign a declaration to the Custodian at any time but on September 15, 1943 he reported that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

However, the North American Life Assurance Co. informed us on October 10, 1942 that this man had a policy with that company. On November 7, 1942 they informed us that this policy had expired.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$6.39 received as refund of 15 wage deduction for 1941. We are remitting this amount to him today.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The Royal Columbian Hospital filed a claim for \$31.40 against this man. This amount was received from INOUYE on April 5, 1944 and the claim paid on April 13, 1944.

This file reveals no other liabilities of any kind.
