Dear Sirs:-

Re: Chiyokichi FUJINO

This letter is with further reference to yours of November 3rd, dealing with the above and other Japanese. We will, in each case, write you a separate letter in order to conform with our filing system whereby we keep a separate case file for each Japanese.

We wrote to this Japanese and referred your proposal to him at the same time pointing out that he owed both you and another party money and unless he could pay this, we would be forced to dispose of his machinery. We have now received his answer together with an enclosed cheque in payment of his other debt and a statement that he will send the money owing to you in March or April. From this we understand that he does not wish his machinery sold and we have written to him to ask him to confirm this.

Under these circumstances, we hope that you will be so good as to continue storing this Japanese' machinery. We are anxious that tools of trade of this nature with which Japanese may continue to be self-supporting, should not be disposed of if the owner can otherwise cover claims against him. Of course, it will be up to him to meet your claim within a reasonable time.
