In reference to your enquiry of November 1st.

We are not aware of any regulation which would prohibit the issuing of a life insurance agent's licence. There is an Order-in-Council prohibiting the acquiring of land by Japanese and also restricting leases to one year, but nothing to prevent a Japanese entering into ordinary business relationships outside of the protected area.
