
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

Further to our letter of June 9th in response to your communication of June 5th regarding the property at 736 - 7th Avenue West, we have to inform you that we were notified yesterday that Mrs. Shibatani and her family had entered Hastings Park, Vancouver. From this we assume that your clients are now in a position to avail themselves of your services in finding a tenant or tenants able to pay.

As we have not yet received the registration of the Mr. Kobayashi mentioned by you, and as we have as yet not received the registration of the Shibatani family, we are not in a position to consider whether or not it would be possible to collect arrears of rent from these people. Our understanding of the matter is that Mr. Kobayashi and his sons rented the upstairs room and that the Shibatani family rented the bottom floor.

As the Shibatani family have not yet registered with us and as they are still in the protected area, their property, if any, has not vested in the Custodian and the Custodian's office does not object to your arranging to secure payment direct, for any sums which may be due for unpaid rent since March 24th last. We note, however, from the letter signed by Mr. K. Shibatani that this family obviously are without funds.
