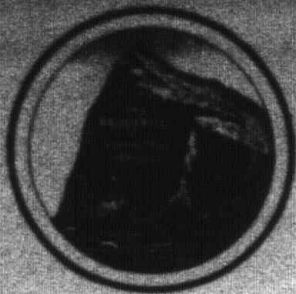

We are in receipt of a post card from one S. TOBO # 604 Internment Camp 101. He states "Received your most unexpected letter of March 23rd concerning about the Singer Machine but have never bought it from you. I guess you have the wrong person so please check it up carefully again".

The only information we have is party was in the Hat Cleaning business at 321 West Cordova and then at 827 East Cprdova St.

The balance is \$80.00 and we have done all we can to locate lessee who has never got in touch with us and nothing has been paid since last June. Would you please release this machine. Cancellation of claim attached.
