PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Ishimatsu HATANAKA, Reg. 07475

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 31, 1942. He was evacuated on July 28, 1942.

In his declaration HATANAKA reported the following chattels stored in stock house at former residence in Bainbridge.

32" Tin Roofing (100 pieces)	1200 lbs. Cascara Bark
2 Pump Jacks	2 9-lb. Sledge Hammers
7'6" Buck Saw	2 9-lb. Fording Wedges
2 Buck Wedges	2 Splitting Wedges
3 Boxes Valves	

On October 14, 1942, Turner Brothers Ltd., Port Alberni, B. C., to whom this office had written in regard to these chattels on September 24, 1942, replied that they had not been able to locate HATANAKA's dwelling. A second report from Turner Brothers Ltd. on December 23, 1942, stated that they had gone to Bainbridge but could get no information in regard to goods stored in the house, and stating that the R.B. McLean Lumber Company, by whom HATANAKA had been employed, could supply no information. On February 1, 1943, we informed HATANAKA that we had been unable to locate his chattels and that we would assume, unless we heard from him to the contrary, that he had disposed of these. No reply was received, so he must have disposed of them himself.

HATANAKA reported a Monarch Life Insurance Company policy on his own life. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

Two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates belonging to Ihino HATANAKA, who has been identified as the same person as Ishimatsu HATANAKA, were received from the R. B. McLean Lumber Company, and are in Custodian safe-keeping. These will be sent to Ishimatsu HATANAKA. *mailed Feb 4, 1947 JMV*

HATANAKA reported a woodshed and a chicken house built on the land on which the house in which he was living was built. These structures he said were his property. However, as he reported in his declaration, that the 2 storey 7 room house in which he had been living had been sold on May 20, 1942, it would appear that the woodshed and chicken house would be included in the sale.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of December 16th, we wish to inform you that income tax refunds are not usually sent to this office. If a letter, sent to the address given on the income tax return, were returned to the Income Tax Department, it is possible that the letter might be sent to this office for forwarding to an Evacuee. We have received no such letters for yourself or for your father. If we should, they will be forwarded to the addresses you have given in your letter.

It is possible that if you were to write the Income Tax Department it might speed up the refund due you, but we are not at all sure about this. It may be that each person has to wait his turn. However, it would not hurt to write them. The address, in the case of returns filed in British Columbia, is Winch Building, Vancouver, B. C.

Would you kindly let us know if you know any person by the name of "Ihino HATANAKA", formerly employed by the R. B. McLean Lumber Company Ltd.? We are endeavouring to find this person, and we believe he may possibly be a member of your family.
