We are in receipt of the above noted Informant's Affidavit of the Business Letter of the said witness, and wish to advise him that we have no record of any fishing nets being owned by his father, Donald John Johnston, deceased. Further, the Informant's father did not declare any assets whatsoever when he registered with the Custodian on April 13, 1946. The only assets, belonging to the Informant's father, of which we have knowledge, are as follows:

1. Long wooden box containing kitchen utensils and dishes.
2. 1 pair rubber boots, size 8.
3. 1 small paper box containing knitting needles and needles

and these were shipped to Vancouver Hospital on March 27, 1946.

Neither the Informant's father nor mother had any funds with the Custodian, and the above effects would, no doubt, be of little value.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant respecting the above and your claim for the recovery of \$50.00 from the Estate of the deceased has been placed on our file.

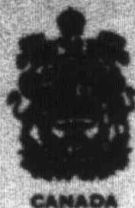
