
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

A review of this file reveals the following claims against the above Japanese person:

Dr. Uchida	- \$3.00
Dr. M. Miyasaki	- \$10.00
Union Fish Co. Ltd.	- \$46.85

The claim of \$3.00 was later withdrawn by Dr. Uchida.

No claim was made by Dr. Miyasaki, the debt being mentioned only by Mrs. Iwama on the back of her Form J card, and it was decided to deal with same on the husband's file. In our letter to Iwama on April 13, 1944 we advised him that as Dr. Miyasaki had not filed a claim against him we would leave the matter to be settled direct and would take no further action.

The claim of \$46.85 by the Union Fish Company was admitted by Mr. Iwama in his letter dated February 15, 1946, in which he again stated he was not in a position to make payment. P. S. Ross & Sons, acting for the above Company, have been advised of this and no further action is being taken by the Custodian.
