This file reveals that KURITA owned no real property in any protected area of D.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Chattels are declared on the wife's file and are dealt with there.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: KURITA declared the sum of \$24.25 owing to him by J. SUZUKI, Internee. J. SUZUKI, Int. File 197, was the owner and publisher of the Canada Daily News, and KURITA worked for him. This was evidently wages owing to KURITA. The account of KURITA has been credited with the sum of \$37.50, representing payment of arrears of wages owing to him by the Canada Daily News. It would seem that KURITA had underestimated the amount owing to him. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

There is a claim on file against him in the sum of \$20.96 and we are writing to him today to find out if this is still owing and if not, whether he wishes us to pay same from his credit with this office.

In his letter of Jan. 29/47 KURITA has requested that this claim be paid. We have therefore transferred the sum of \$20.96 from his account to the account of T. Maikawa Stores Ltd. and remitted the balance of \$16.54 to KURITA.
