This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on July 28, 1942. The declaration was signed at Hope, B. C. after his evacuation.

In this declaration he reported ownership of no property of any kind. No property of any kind, identified as belonging to this man, has come under the control of this office.

This file reveals the following liabilities:

1. Matsui TANAKA, File #081A - \$5.80. This was paid from funds remitted by MUKUYAMA for that purpose on March 3, 1943.
2. The Department of Labour, Japanese Division, filed claim for \$20.00 funeral expenses in connection with the funeral of an infant of whom MUKUYAMA was the father. This claim has been placed on the file of the mother, Misao OSAWA, File 10222, as well as on this file. The Department of Labour have been informed that no funds are standing to the credit of either of the parents.
