Re: Policy #2,211,827-Yoshimichi Uno-Your File #12080

With reference to your letter of the 23rd instant, with enclosure, also our telephone conversation to-day with your Mr. Spain, we would confirm that the above numbered policy lapsed by reserve exhaustion on August 16, 1943, the policy having no equity after that date. It may be mentioned that Mr. Uno borrowed \$200.00 on his policy in 1941 and paid no subsequent premiums, causing the policy to cancel on the date mentioned.

It is not our practice to hand out cash surrender value application forms indiscriminately and the clerk who furnished you with the forms in question had, of course, no authority to do so. We would ask you, therefore, to return to us any unused forms in your possession, and in future should you have occasion to request cash surrender value forms, that you telephone us, giving particulars of the policy number. The records will then be checked, and if the policy is in full force and effect, you will be immediately furnished with an application form for the designated policy for the required signatures.
