PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 12086

Re: Chiyo KOBAYASHI #01737

This woman was evacuated on February 28, 1942, but did not sign a declaration to the Custodian until March 18, 1946. Her husband, however, had signed a declaration on April 7, 1943.

The only property reported by Mrs. KOBAYASHI and her husband were their chattels, which had been left in the house of her father, File 4951, at 137 West 8th. These chattels were confused with those of other members of the family, but each of the persons concerned examined the auction sheets and straightened out the matter of ownership. The net proceeds from the sale of chattels identified as the property of Mrs. KOBAYASHI were credited to her account in the sum of \$99.92. Eight items were shipped to her in 1943.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.

As the sum of \$99.92, standing to the credit of this account was derived from the sale of chattels declared by both Mrs. Chiyo KOBAYASHI and her husband, Saburo KOBAYASHI this sum is being transferred from the account of the Estate of Mrs. KOBAYASHI, who died at Toronto, Ontario, on November 14, 1946, to the account of Saburo KOBAYASHI; There being no conclusive evidence of individual ownership of the chattels involved, it is assumed that the surviving claimant is entitled to the proceeds of the sale.
