MEMORANDUM

Deceased.

Attached is Government of British Columbia cheque in the sum of \$32.74 sent to us at the request of Claude Macdonald, Official Administrator of the Estate of Sentaro Tsujimura, our File 12103.

This man died at Kaslo, B.C. on April 1, 1944 and while his declaration indicated that he was a widower and had no children, the letter of the Official Administrator dated March 27, 1945 indicates that the deceased was supposed to have had a wife and five children in Japan.

I think under the circumstances we may hold these funds for the heirs in Japan and I can think of no other heading for this account than "Heirs of Sentaro Tsujimura, Japan", and would ask you to credit this accordingly.

Re Estate of Sentaro Tsujimura

The above-named estate was turned over to me for attention following Mr. Tsujimura's death at the Victorian Hospital, Kaslo, B.C., on April 1st, 1944, as the Deceased had no relatives in this country.

The only assets in the estate were some personal effects which were sold at the time for the sum of \$37.24. The only expense involved in administering the estate was the sum of \$4.50 for fees for Letters of Administration. The balance on hand is the difference between these two amounts, namely \$32.74, and I would like to know whether it would be in order to have same paid over to you for disposal.

The Deceased was a Japanese National and at the time of his death he was supposed to have had a wife and five children in Japan. The last known address of the widow is Mrs. Katsu Tsujimura, 563 Shinchii, Yanaimachi, Kugagun, Yamaguchi-ken, Japan.
