SUMMARY of LIABILITIES

The above Japanese person declared on his JP form dated August 3, 1942 that he owed \$100.00 each to his father-in-law, Buichi RAKANO, and his two brothers, Tadanasa and Tsuneharu WATANABE. We wrote to Hideyoshi Watanabe on January 24, 1946 asking him to advise us if these claims had been settled, to which he replied on January 28 that he had paid these relatives direct in Tashu, B.C.

Although not declared, a review of this file revealed that a claim for \$6.85 by the B. C. Telephone Company was lodged against this Evacuee, trading as "University Cleaners" on May 20, 1942, for exchange services between March 1, 1942 and April 2, 1942. We advised Watanabe of this claim but in his reply dated January 28, 1946 he denied this debt, stating he had moved from that establishment at the end of February 1942. We advised the creditor accordingly and gave them the address of this Evacuee that they might contact him direct if they so desired.

NO FURTHER ACTION REGARDING CLAIMS AGAINST THIS JAPANESE PERSON IS BEING TAKEN BY THE CUSTODIAN.
