

A review of this file reveals that the following claim was lodged against T. Taki, Balmoral Cannery, B. C.:

Dr. C.H. Hankinson,
Prince Rupert, B. C. - \$15.00.

On April 3, 1944 we advised the above Evacuee of this claim against him but received no reply. We wrote again under date of June 23, 1944 and received a reply dated July 17, 1944, in which Tokujiro TAKI denied the above claim. We therefore wrote to Dr. C. H. Hankinson under date of July 31, 1944 advising him that we had submitted his claim to Tokujiro TAKI for payment and that we had received the following reply:


"I have received letter from you indicating \$15.00 - Dr. C.H. Hankinson. But I do not know anything about it. I am sure I don't own anybody \$15.00."

We asked Dr. Hankinson to give us further particulars of his debtor, after which we would investigate the account further, otherwise we would be unable to take any further action. We also gave him the address of the Evacuee at that time, and told him that we would take no further action but would await his reply. The Evacuee was advised of our action in this matter.

As no reply was received from Dr. Hankinson regarding his claim against T. Taki, no further action was taken by the Custodian's Office.

No other claims against the above Japanese person are revealed on this file.


