Your undated letter regarding a perambulator came to hand on the 23rd June last, and owing to the absence of the writer on holiday, and the necessity of a thorough check-up by our Chattels Representative, we have been delayed in answering.

We now have a report from this representative who states as follows:-

"apart from chattels sold by us in Auction No.39 the entire contents, chattels and equipment were sold to Mr. Dorigan as per receipt on file dated Jan. 29th 1943."

It would seem therefore that Mr. Dorigan in his purchase took over the entire contents and that the perambulator, if there at the time, was included in the purchase price.

In view of the report of our Chattels Representative we do not see that we can do anything more in regard to this matter.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter on the 7th instant of two undated letters from you in reply to ours of the 23rd ultimo.

One of them was a typewritten letter and requested that we forward to you a radio and a camera. As we had just sent you an account of the sale of a radio, and as we did not have a record of any other radio of yours here, we shall be obliged if you will let us know if you had more than one that was sold. Before the funds derived from the sale of this radio are released, we require to have the R.C.M.P. receipt which you hold, forwarded to this office, and this we ask you to do in your next letter to the Custodian.

Regarding the camera we wish to say that if you will please forward to this office the R.C.M.P. receipt held by you we shall attend to the forwarding of the camera as you request.

Your other letter was in connection with the prices obtained for your chattels, and in reply we wish to advise that the usual procedure was followed in making the sales. The main articles were advertised in the daily papers here and when no acceptable bid was received, sale was made to Mr. Dorigan at the best price obtainable. The other chattels were sold by auction to the highest bidder. No other way of making these sales could be fair to you.
