We submitted the above claim to Miss HAMAGUCHI and also to her father, Juzo HAMAGUCHI, for payment. We have had two replies from Miss HAMAGUCHI, who according to our records must have been 17 years old or less when she became a patient in the T.B. Unit.

In the first letter she says "I really don't know what it is all about." In the second letter she goes into the matter somewhat by saying, among other things, as follows:

"When I was sent to Tranquille in the year 1935, it was understood by the hospital representative how impossible it was for us to pay them, otherwise my father would have never sent me there."

We have not heard from the father as yet, except that the daughter in her second letter stated as follows:

"My father is a very sick man, besides he worries a great deal wondering if I am getting enough to get by. So please do not worry him too much."

There are very substantial claims lodged by your department against Juzo HAMAGUCHI, including this one, all of which seem pretty hopeless of collection, now or ever.

There are no funds on hand for either the father or the daughter, and neither one has declared any assets on their cards on file with the Custodian.

We wish to acknowledge receipt of yours of the 8th inst. in reply to ours of the 29th ult. regarding claims. In our letter of the 29th to which you reply it is noted that we did not refer to "Mental Hospital." The one in which you were a patient was a T.B. Unit, and this is confirmed by your letter stating that you went to Tranquille in 1935. Our letter of the 30th September last did refer to Provincial Mental Hospital, T.B. Unit, but this should have read Provincial Board of Health, T.B. Unit.

In the closing paragraph of our letter of the 29th October last we stated that we were submitting the claim to your father, Juzo HAMAGUCHI. This we did, with other claims.

We wish you and him to understand, however, that the Custodian does not intend to oppress either of you in any way in carrying out the duties of this office. We must have the files show if claims are correct or otherwise, and also what the prospects are for payment if they are correct and properly lodged.

If payment cannot be made the creditors are so advised, and the efforts of the Custodian's office practically cease in so far as the Claims Department is concerned.
