Mitsuo Hattori died at New Denver, B. C. on October 23, 1946. At the time of his death he was twenty-seven years of age and unmarried. He is survived by his mother, Toru (Mrs. Hichisuke) Sakai.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none appear on the file other than a "Cub" Camera which was taken from Hattori by the R. C. M. P. and turned over to the Custodian. This camera was found to be in a damaged condition and unsaleable.
