
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

April 26, 1946.

Re: Kumao NAGANO, Reg. No. 07439

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on August 7, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind.

However, the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.30 received from the Provincial Government as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941.

On June 14, 1943, NAGANO informed us that Hirokichi SHINTANI, File No. 13810, owed him \$120.00. SHINTANI admitted the debt but at that time had no funds so was then unable to pay. Since that time, however SHINTANI's account has been credited with sufficient funds to pay this debt.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
