CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on August 7th, 1942, and was evacuated on Sept. 19/42, declared no chattels. However 4 chairs removed from 157 West 2nd Ave. were identified as belonging to him, and were sold at auction for the net sum of \$1.34, and this amount was credited to his account.
On Sept. 22nd, 1942, a Mrs. Ei SAKURADA declared that about one ton of old newspaper clippings were in the basement at 157 West 2nd Ave. belonging to the above, and suggested this be packed preparatory to shipping it to NAGAO. These clippings were however abandoned as being of no value, and at no time has NAGAO personally written us on this subject.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

In your registration form of August 7th, you declared no property, but on September 22nd a friend of your wife's advised us that she required a box of valuable newspaper clippings left in the basement of 157 West 2nd Avenue, to be removed to safe storage.

On investigation we find many bundles of old newspapers totalling more than one ton in weight. We cannot possibly move these to storage but as the building is unlikely to be rented, they can, for the time being, remain where they are.

Please write to us and tell us what you wish done with these papers. We suggest that they be given to the Red Cross for use in the war effort.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you registered with the Custodian at Hastings Park, you declared no property of any description.
