
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

Specified Articles: No specified articles were revealed or declared on this file.

Chattels: The above Evacuee declared 1 bedroom suite, 1 kitchen stove, 2 carpets, 1 box Japanese dolls, 5 boxes kitchenware and silverware, 1 baby bed and 1 cupboard, in her JP form dated August 12th, 1942, these to be left in two upstairs rooms at the property 55 W. 5th Ave., Vancouver. However, it is revealed in a letter dated July 23, 1943, that our investigators were informed that this Evacuee had removed all chattels from the premises, leaving nothing but some junk which was discarded, and as Mrs. Nishikawa did not reply to our Protection Department's query as to whether this information was correct, it is assumed that the chattels were removed by the Evacuees.

Certificates: A \$5.00 War Savings Certificate was declared by this Evacuee to be in her possession. No action taken by the Custodian regarding this Certificate.

Bank Account: This Evacuee declared \$1100.00 as being held in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings, Vancouver. It is revealed on the husband's file that this money was held in a joint account in the names of Nobujiro and Fusaye Nishikawa (Husband and Wife) and that this money was transferred to them at Tashme, B. C., by the Bank in June 1943.

Life Insurance: Mrs. Nishikawa declared a \$500.00 Prudential Life Insurance Policy, No. 412715063, beneficiary being her husband, Nobujiro, and also a \$500.00 Prudential Life policy, No. 412818093, in the name of her daughter, Michiko, beneficiary being the declarant. This Evacuee states that both policies are in her possession. No action regarding the above policies has been taken by the Custodian.
