
The above Japanese declared no liabilities and no assets with the exception of a \$1,000.00 Sun Life Insurance policy which was not brought under control by the Custodian.

The Pacific Co-operative Union gave notice through this office, which was forwarded to the Japanese on March 11, 1944, that a Mutual Aid Fund policy would lapse if dues of \$1.00 were not paid within 30 days. No reply was received to our letter and no further action was taken by this office.

The records of the United Farmers Co-operative Union showed that Mrs. FUJIKAWA was the registered holder of a \$10.00 share in that co-operative. The Custodian sold this share for \$65.00 and this together with \$3.20 interest on same which had been paid into this office to her credit, was sent to her on March 11, 1946 upon her son bringing the share certificate into this office.

This file reveals no assets or liabilities and requires no further administration.
