GENERAL SUMMARY

File 12271.

Gorosuke MUKAI

Reg. No. 08023.

This 55-year old Carpenter, a Japanese-National, from Nanaimo, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 9th February, 1943. He was evacuated on the 19th March, 1942. He died at Tashme, B. C., on the 26th May, 1944.

He declared his wife and child to be living in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Personal Property: Shipping release and copy of Bill of Lading on file show that two packages containing carpenter's tools were shipped from Otter Bay, Port Washington, to 11 Mile Camp, near Hope, B. C., on July 11th, 1942.

Bills Receivable: On the 13th January, 1943, we received from P. S. Ross & Sons, liquidators of Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd., two War Savings Certificates (@ \$5.00) in the name of Gorosuke MUKAI. These certificates are held in safe custody by this office.

Another War Savings Certificate (1 @ \$10.00) declared in "JP" form, remained in declarant's possession, and did not come under our administration.

Bank Accounts: None.

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: There are no claims recorded in this file.

Funds: There is no ledger account in this name at the present time.


