Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, together with receipt which you received from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at the time the radio was surrendered. We now enclose our cheque in the sum of \$22.95, being the net proceeds from sale of your radio, and as this is your entire credit balance with the Custodian, we are closing your file.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you registered with the Custodian on August 20th, 1942, you stated that you had no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia.

A refund of 1% wage deductions in the sum of \$5.10 for the first six months of 1941 was received from the Provincial Collector, and a cheque for this amount was remitted to you on June 26th, 1943.

We were advised by the Sun Life Assurance Company that you had a life insurance policy with their company. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
