Please be advised that the Commissioner of Income Tax has forwarded to us a cheque for \$3.90 representing refund of 1% wage deduction for the period January 1st, 1941 to June 30th, 1941. We have instructed our Accounting Department to issue a cheque for the same amount payable to you and you may therefore anticipate receiving it shortly.

This opportunity is taken to acknowledge your letter dated October 10th from which we observe that you have no property in the protected area and that you have been living in Kelowna ever since 1929. It will, of course, be unnecessary, under the circumstances, for you to register your life insurance policy with the Custodian's office.

Purely in order that our records may be entirely complete would you please be kind enough to send us a letter by return mail giving us the full names and police registration numbers of each member of your family, and if all such members have been residing outside the protected area since the first of this year we would appreciate your so informing us.
