PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: YOSHIDA, Tomekichi - Reg. No. 08527.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian to the effect that he had no property of any kind, on July 13, 1942 and had previously been evacuated on March 17, 1942 from Chemainus to Hastings Park.

CHATELS: He declared no chattels but requested shipment of 2 saws and a sleigh left at House #7, Chemainus. As was customary, we have no real confirmation of shipment having been received, but in the absence of any renewed request, it is assumed that the articles were received by the Japanese. The saws were declared by his wife, Hina, File 8255.

A few chattels were sold by auction. Only two chairs could be identified as belonging to his wife and the proceeds were transferred to her account. The other goods could not be identified as belonging either to Tomekichi or to his wife and were therefore transferred to Suspense Account.

Mr. James advised us that he had shipped for storage at Vancouver 1 box of brass and 1 box of books marked T. YOSHIDA, Chemainus. Inventory 736, shows only 1 carton and Mr. Wills advises us that he can locate only one item marked T. YOSHIDA. This is being held with the personal goods at 604 East Cordova.

MONEYS

OWING: A refund of 1% Wage deduction was received from the Provincial Collector and remitted to the Japanese on April 8, 1943. It represented deductions made during the period between January and June 1941 and amounted to \$7.22.
