This 56-year old Hillbani, a Japanese National, from Port Alberni, signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 30th October, 1942. He was single at date of evacuation (Mar. 12/42).

Bank Accounts: None.


Life Insurance: None.

Your file has been up for review and we take advantage of this opportunity to give you a brief resume of the contents thereof.

In the Custodian "No Property" card signed by you on the 30th October, 1942, you declared that you owned no property, real or personal, in the protected area of British Columbia.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 15 wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, was collected by this office and credited to your account in the sum of \$5.54.

Refund of part payment of a Victory Bond was received from the Alberni Pacific Lumber Company through the Canadian Bank of Commerce and credited to your account in the sum of \$5.65.

Liabilities: No action was taken by this office with regard to a claim of \$107.00, filed against you by Mr. Kanoo UI, who has since returned to Japan, but to complete our records we desire to know if this claim was settled by you direct with Mr. UI, and we would be obliged if you would supply us with this information.

Funds: There is a balance of \$11.19 in your account at the present time. As no further entries are expected we are enclosing our cheque in your favour for \$11.19. This will leave no balance in your account, which will then be closed.

This would appear to account for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience.
