



This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on November 15, 1942, after his evacuation on August 1, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a bed and dress cabinet but did not report where they were. We assume they were of no value as nothing further appears on the file.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$6.38 as refund of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ wage deduction for 1941. This was remitted to him on November 24, 1942.
