

GENERAL SUMMARY

On June 29, 1943, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian in which he reported no property of any kind.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$6.51, as refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941. This sum was remitted to him on July 14, 1943.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$19.80, being net proceeds from the sale of a radio, which Toshiso KITAGAWA, Internee #115 805 by whom the radio had been surrendered, stated was the property of Kanjiro TAKEMURA. The receipt was sent to us by KITAGAWA with his request that the funds be placed to the credit of TAKEMURA. These funds are being remitted to TAKEMURA Today.

The Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada reported Policy No. 2214167 on the life of this man. This did not come under the control of this office.

The file of Mrs. Kanjiro TAKEMURA, File 9564, reveals neither assets nor liabilities.
