

The tenant of 856 Powell Street, Mrs. Bloudoff, called on the writer the other day with your letter of April 6th. She had no knowledge of any of the goods set out therein.

We should mention that Nobujiro Koide did not register with the Custodian until March 3rd, 1944 so that for nearly two years this office had no record of anything belonging to him.

Reference to our files shows that the owner of the premises at 856 Powell Street is a Mr. Masao Ohara. On October 9th, 1942, we wrote to him that investigation showed that the few belongings left in his house had been given to the tenant in exchange for decorating the premises and the balance of no value, were discarded. We are not sure that this letter was ever received by Mr. Ohara as there was at that time some doubt of his correct address. On June 15th, 1943, he asked for the shipment of kitchenware from the attic of this house but does not appear to have followed up our request for a standard Custodian Release.

The present tenants, Mr. and Mrs. Bloudoff, have been in occupancy since June 1st, 1942, that is, prior to the evacuation of Mr. Ohara on July 13th and it seems unlikely, therefore, that there would have been any misunderstandings. Under these circumstances, we do not think that anything more can be done.
