GENERAL SUMMARY

This 53-year old Japanese-National Millhand from Port Alice, B. C., signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 15th December, 1942. He was a widower at date of evacuation (Mar. 31/42).

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Bank Accounts: None.


