PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

October 6, 1945.

Re: Tama UCHIYAMA, Reg. No. 07749

This person, who was evacuated on September 8, 1942, stated in her declaration to the Custodian, on August 21, 1942, that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever left in the protected area.

However, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported that this person had surrendered a camera. Details of this article are given in the Specified Articles Memorandum, which also shows that the camera was shipped to Tama UCHIYAMA.

The file reveals no evidence of ownership of a vessel, motor-vehicle, radio or firearm.

The file reveals no evidence of ownership of any other personal property of any kind.

Dear Madam:

As requested by you we mailed your camera to you by insured parcel post on October 2nd. Your camera should be in your hands by the time this letter reaches you. Postage on this camera amounted to 20 cents. We are returning 30 cents in stamps, as you sent us 50 cents to cover the postage.

In your declaration to the Custodian you stated that you owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area, and the only property of yours of which we have any record is the camera. This camera was reported by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police as having been surrendered by you, and the receipt which you sent to this office confirmed this report.

It is felt that we have accounted for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge receipt of the camera and stamps, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope. You will find the 30 cents in stamps inside the envelope.
