Purchasers' Co-Operative Assn. made up to April 30th, 1942 and according to that statement the sum claimed against Mr. Uwate had not been paid at that time. Prior to the Officers of the Co-Operative Association leaving Vancouver they notified us from time to time of payments but the claim against Yoshio Uwate was not among them. It would appear, therefore, that this account has not been paid."
