He further stated that he sold some Bedreon furniture for \$89.00 for which he had received the sash. His own meagre effects were 2 eases of books and household goods, all of which would not be worth more than \$10. These 2 eases he stated he was going to store with his uncle, Dr. I. Shimo-takars at 214 Powell St. Teneouver".
