GENERAL SUMMARY

Mr. SHIMOTAKAHARA made his declaration to the Custodian on Aug. 21/42 and was evacuated on March 10/42. He declared no chattels of any kind. However he did surrender to the R.C.M.P. on March 10/42 a Victor mantel radio. This was handed over by them to the Custodian on Feb. 17/44 and sold at auction for the net sum of \$23.27 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

He declared twelve \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

There are no claims on file against him. There are no claims on the file of his wife, File 10960.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
