Re: Jinjiro HARA #04328,  
Your letter Jan. 11/45.

We note the above named is a permanent maintenance case. Our file records gives the following information:

1. We have addressed several letters to him with a request that he fill in and return our usual registration form. He failed to comply with our requirements.
2. According to his declaration given at the Petawawa Internment Camp, he left personal property valued at \$800.00, at 1740 Powell Street.
3. All chattels found at 1740 Powell Street were sold in the name of the Landlord, Hatsu IKEDA, (file 11069).

If Mr. Hara is to obtain his share of the proceeds of auction, we would require a full list of his chattels left at 1740 Powell Street. We would like to have Mr. Ikeda confirm the ownership.
